We specialise in the sale, servicing and repair of tyre changing machines to Business Clients and are based near Grantham, Lincolnshire.

Our Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking policy reflects our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships and to ensure that slavery and human trafficking are not taking place within Our Organisation.

We have considered the risk profile of our business and our business partners. We comply, and will continue to comply, with the highest professional standards. We expect that any business partners, whether subcontractors or Third Parties interacting with our business will adhere to appropriate standards of conduct.

We have undertaken a risk-based review to identify and assess potential risk areas in our relationships with the contractors and the suppliers that we use and have set up a register detailing the same.

In order to ensure that all our suppliers and contractors comply with our values, all of our significant suppliers should agree to comply with our Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking policy within their own business and their supply chains, or have their own equivalent policy in place. .

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our business, we distributed this policy amongst all *Workers*, so it can be easily accessible. Staff are required to sign a formal acknowledgment of these arrangements.

Everyone in the firm is encouraged to report any concerns regarding slavery and/or human trafficking in accordance with our whistleblowing policy.

This statement is made pursuant to Section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015. It will be periodically reviewed.
